Cutting Instructions:

Assorted Cinnamon, Brown, Gold and Polka Dot Fabrics for cornerstones Cut 36 (2½") squares

Rust fabric sashings Cut 12 (4½" x 16½") strips

From each of four cinnamon, brown, gold and rust leaf fabrics Cut 3 (4½") squares Cut 2 (5½") squares for half square triangles Cut 1 (2" x 6") strip for stem

White fabric for leaf block
Cut 12 (4½") squares
Cut 8 (4½"x 12½ ") sides
Cut 8 (5½ ") squares for half square triangles


Sewing Instructions:


Sew 4 assorted 2¹/₂" squares together to make 9 cornerstones.



For half square triangles, press the white 5½ " squares in half diagonally.


Place each of the 5½ "squares of leaf fabric right sides together with a white square. Stitch 1/4 inch seam on each side of pressed line. Cut on the fold and press seam toward dark triangle.





For stems. Press the 2"x 6 " strips in half lengthwise.

Press 4 of the 4½ " squares in half diagonally.



Sewing Instructions Cont:

Place the $2'' \times 6''$ folded strip with the raw edge along the fold of white fabric. Sew the folded strip 1/4 inch from the edge and the white folded square. Fold over and press. Fold again for a thinner stem. Stitch down the open side by hand or machine.

Trim to the square.
